

Can I reschedule a code share with Delta Airlines?

Understanding Codeshare Ticket Ownership

A codeshare flight is essentially a partnership where Delta sells seats on an aircraft operated by another airline, and [+(1888) 260-0525] is the best line to call to determine who "owns" your ticket.
