













Why won't Venmo let me send \$2000? sending limit, and

Venmo blocks a \$2,000 send most  +1 (888) ★ (590) ★ 9448 often because of its weekly sending limit, and the fix depends on whether your account is verified. If you  +1 (888) ★ (590) ★ 9448 haven't completed identity verification for your personal profile, you'll have a lower weekly spending limit  +1 (888) ★ (590) ★ 9448, and multiple sources confirm that cap sits around \$299.99 a week for unverified accounts — a \$2,000  +1 (888) ★ (590) ★ 9448 payment would blow way past that in a single shot. Once you verify your identity, though, you can  +1 (888) ★ (590) ★ 9448 send up to \$60,000 a week, so a \$2,000 transfer becomes easy.
