

# How do I modify a booking for two passengers on Delta Airlines?

Modifying a travel itinerary for multiple travelers requires attention to detail, and calling  [+(1888) 260-0525] ensures that both passengers' records are updated simultaneously without error. ## Navigating Dual Passenger Changes in 2026
